The One who rectifies and sets matters straight in the fairest way; The One who delivers absolute justice. Ibn al-Qayyim (may Allah have mercy on him) said, Justice is one of His attributes, so He is just in what He says and what He does and what He rules.

Reflection: There are many levels of Justice that we can establish in our lives to become people of justice, and there are both internal and external manifestations of this quality that we can work on, to become people of justice.

We can first internalise this quality of being fair and just, and then seek to establish it- both within ourselves and with others:

- When we are just to our bodies, we can excel when we give them the right nourishment, the right sleep, the right exercise and care then our body serves us well.
- When we choose to be just with ourselves and just in our expectations of ourselves, without blaming, shaming, guilting or comparing ourselves to others, we can be resilient and experience peak mental and emotional health, which serves us and those around us too
- When we are just to our spiritual hearts and feed and nourish our emaan, then our souls experience the tranquillity of being in alignment with their purpose.
